Authors submitting their papers to be considered for publication in one of ATINER's publications should make a note of the following:

- 1. All ATINER's publications, including the e-journals, are open access, without any costs (submission, processing, publishing, open access paid by authors, open access paid by readers etc.) and they are independent of the presentations made at any of the many small events (conferences, symposiums, forums, colloquiums, courses, roundtable discussions) organized by ATINER throughout the year. The intellectual property rights of the submitted papers remain with the author and there is no request of copyright transfer.
- 2. Before submitting your full paper, make sure it is written in proper English.
- 3. Unless required by the subject matter of the paper, an effort should be made to only include references available in English.
- 4. All papers are reviewed by at least two independent academics. The final decision is made by one of the editors, based on (a) Research Design & Methodology, (b) Theoretical Background, (c) Review of the Relevant Literature, (d) Significance of Themes, (e) Relevance of Themes, (f) Clarity and Communication of Arguments Presented, (g) Clarity of Conclusions, and (h) Overall Quality of Analysis.
